

# farmhouse craft box

## Extra Supplies needed:

- 120 grit sandpaper and sanding block
- Glue gun
- Scissors
- Old Store Card
- Iron
- Baking Paper
- Kraft knife
- Clear Wax

## Bake It Till You Make It Tea towel

1. Give your tea towel a really good iron removing any crinkles.
2. Using your old store card burnish the front and the back of your Bake It Till You Make is stencil.
3. Remove the backing paper from your stencil and carefully line up over your tea towel. Press firmly over your stencil with your hands and then burnish with your store card. Remove the transfer paper.
4. Pop out some Fusion Mineral Paint – Coal Black and load up your foam wedge. Pounce off any excess paint and stencil away.
5. Let the paint completely dry and carefully remove the vinyl stencil. Remove all the letter inserts.
6. Place a piece of baking paper over the top of your design and using your iron with NO STEAM heat set.

## Home Sweet Home Mini Book Stack

1. Give the mini book stack a really good sand with your 120 grit sandpaper.
2. Using your brush give 2 pieces of wood a coat of Black let dry and repeat.
3. Then give the other piece 2 coats of Casement. You can swap the colours around if you would like white to be the main colour.
4. Using your old store card burnish the Home Sweet Home Stencils.
5. Remove the backing paper to the Home Stencil and apply to one of the Black wood pieces. Press firmly with your store card, then remove the transfer paper.
6. Repeat with the other blocks.
7. Pop out some white and black paint. Stencil the black on your white block and white on your black block and let completely dry.
8. Remove the transfer sheets and all the letter inserts. You may need a craft knife.

9. Distress to your liking and seal with wax. Wrap with jute and tie in a bow to create your book stack.

### Milk & Cream Sign

1. Give your wooden sign a really good sand with 120 grit sandpaper.
2. Apply 2 coats of Casement letting each coat dry completely.
3. Burnish your Milk & Cream Stencil and remove the backing paper.
4. Line up with your stencil and apply. Rub over the stencil with your fingers and then burnish with your store card.
5. Remove the transfer sheet.
6. Load up your foam wedge with Casement and stencil. Let dry.
7. Carefully remove the stencil and all letter inserts.
8. Distress to your liking and wax to seal.
