## Extra Supplies Needed:

- \* 120 grit sandpaper
- \* wood glue
- \* Paper plate or something to put your paint out onto
- \* Plastic cup or glass jar
- \* Old Store Card
- \* Craft Knife
- \* Glue Gun

## Craft Space/Room Double Sided Sign

1. Using your 120 grit sandpaper give both sides of the sign a good sand to get rid of any raised areas to prevent any paint from bleeding under your stencils.
2. Take the chux cloth provided in your box and dampen with water. Mix a small amount of Chocolate in your plastic cup or glass jar to create a stain. Wipe onto the entire sign. Let dry.
3. Using your old store card rub firmly over both of the larger stencils. Remove backing paper, center and apply the stencil. Again with your store card press firmly over the design. Remove the transfer paper.
4. Pop some Raw Silk paint out. Then place the sponge onto your index finger and dip into the paint. Pounce a few times to get rid of any excess paint. It is much better to go on lightly and do 2 - 3 coats to prevent bleeding under your stencil. Make sure you let each coat dry properly.
5. Once completely dry, peel away the stencil. Use your craft knife to remove any inserts from the letters. Be sure your careful not scratch your paint.
