Extra Supplies Needed:

- * 120 grit sandpaper
- * wood glue
- * Drill or screw driver
- * Old Store Card

Kitchen Tea Towel Ladder

1. Add some wood glue to the end of the smaller pieces marked A & C. Not too much otherwise the glue will seep out & effect your stain. Lining up your long wood piece marked A & C to the smaller pieces marked A & C with the counter sunk longer piece facing outwards. Pop in the screws from the surprise box & tighten but not all the way. Repeat with the other side B to B & D to D. {See diagram}

2. Tighten all the screws & make sure that the rungs of the ladder are straight. Wipe away any excess glue. Let dry over night.

3. Taking the plastic cup provided, pop in about 1 tbs of MMS Milk Paint - Curio & about 1 1/2 tbs of warm water. You want the mix to be watery. Mix with the paddle pop stick until all the powder is dissolved. Make sure that there is no powder in the bottom of your cup. Set aside for about 5 minutes.

4. Mix your milk paint again & take the chux cloth & stain the entire ladder. Let dry. Depending on how dark you want your ladder to be apply more coats. I applied 2 coats for the ladder in pictured in the instructions. Feel free to distress if you want.

If you have any left over stain, tightly cover with cling wrap & use within 7 days on another project.
