

# easter box

## Extra Supplies needed:

- old store card or scraper
- glue gun
- 120 grit sandpaper
- Scissors
- Wax to seal
- Old toothbrush or short bristled brush

## Bunny Please Stop Here Sign

1. Give your bunny a really good sand.
2. Then 1 coat of Champlain and let dry.
3. Then give 1 coat of Pebble and let dry.
4. Distress the bunny around the edges and across the front to let the white come through.
5. Rub over firmly the "Easter Bunny Please Stop Here" stencil with your old store card or scraper and remove the backing paper.
6. Line up the stencil across the belly of your bunny and apply.
7. Rub firmly with your store card or scraper.
8. Lightly pounce on some Champlain and let dry. Repeat.
9. Remove the stencil and all letter inserts.
10. Wax if you are going to leave your bunny outside for protection.
11. Using your glue gun glue on the flowers and beads to the bunnies head to create a flower crown.

## Easter Egg Welcome Attachment

1. Give the square piece of wood in your kit a really good sand.
2. Make a wash with some Champlain and apply using the chux cloth. Let dry.
3. Rub over firmly the Easter Egg Stencil with your old store card or scraper and remove the backing paper.
4. Line the stencil up and apply.
5. Lightly pounce on some Heirloom and let dry. Repeat.
6. BEFORE you remove the outer edge of the stencil remove the bunny part of the stencil and with a dry old tooth brush light splatter some Champlain to give a nice speckled effect. You can also add some Pebble as well. Let dry.
7. Remove the stencil and apply the magnet to the back and hang on your welcome sign!
