


door hanger box

Extra Supplies needed:

- 120 Grit Sandpaper
- Glue Gun
- Wax to seal your project
- Painters tape
- Drill
- Damask Stencil from last month's box

Welcome to Our Home Door Hanger

1. Give the front of your wooden round, a really good sand with 120 grit sandpaper.
2. Damped your sponge brush and give the front of the circle a 2 coats of Dixie Belle - Dusty Blue.
3. Grab the Damask Stencil from last month's box, and line up about 12cm from the top and the centre of the tray. Use painters tape to hold in place.
4. Taking the foam wedge stencil using Fusion - Casement. Let dry and then move the stencil to the side and line up again over lapping the stencil and stencil to the side of the tray.
5. Repeat on the other side and let dry.
6. Distress to your liking.
7. Line up the Welcome To Our Home Stencil.
8. Use painters tape to hold in place.
9. Stencil using Fusion- Coal Black.
10. Let dry and distress the lettering to your liking.
11. Seal with wax.
12. Taking your drill, make two holes in the top of the door hanger.
13. Tread trough the rope from back to front and tie off. Use painters tape in the end of your rope if you're having difficulties threading it through.
14. Thread through your beads and tie off at the front with a double knot.
15. Make a bow from the wired ribbon and glue into place with your glue gun.
16. Then behind the bow glue the greenery into place.
