Extra Supplies needed:

- * 120 grit Sandpaper
- * Brush
- * Old card or scraper
- * Glue Gun
- * Mod podge or clear coat
- * wax

Welcome Every Bunny Sign :

1. Give your wooden sign a really good sand with 120 grit sandpaper.
2. Then give the sign a coat of Cathedral Taupe.
3. Using your old store card or scraper burnish firmly the back and front of your stencil. Carefully remove the backing paper of your stencil and adhere to your sign.
4. Burnish over the top of your stencil and carefully remove the transfer paper.
5. Take your stencilling sponge and lightly stencil in Fusion – Casement and let dry then seal with wax.
6. Make your bow using the floral ribbon and lace and glue to your sign using your glue gun.
7. Glue your sweet bunny head just below your bow.

Carrot Sign

1. Give your square sign a really good sand with 120 grit sandpaper.
2. Then paint with Fusion – Casement. Let dry and repeat. Wax to seal.
3. Carefully glue the orange ribbon in the shape of a carrot (please refer to the picture) starting at the top and then working your way to the bottom looping and gluing the ribbon as you go.
4. Glue the carrot top to the top of the carrot.
5. Then glue your stamped carrot label down the side of the sign.

Decoupage Easter Tag

1. Lightly sand you tag and give it one coat of Casement.
2. Carefully tear around the outside of your decoupage paper to give an old look.
3. Apply the decoupage paper to the tag using a piece of scrunched up piece of cling wrap to remove any wrinkles. Let dry and then seal with your medium.
4. Apply some antiquing wax or left over tobacco road over the top of your tag to give it an aged look. Or any watered down brown paint will do the trick too.
5. Carefully glue down the Spanish Moss to your tag and then glue the paper flower in place.
6. Make a bow for the top of the tag with the lace and burlap.
7. Grab the end of a paint brush and wrap the pip berries around the end to create a spiral and glue in place at the top of your tag.
8. Lay the bow over the top and glue in place.
10. Using some left over jute make loop and thread it through the top of your tag.
